Donations can also be left at the Colton & Uniontown Post Offices - boxes will be available from December 4th – 8th in both lobbies.

Please follow these guidelines:

- NO glass
- NO perishables
- NO pasta / rice / flour / sugar – the packaging gets damaged & is unusable
- Boxes and cans are safest
- Please check expiration dates on the items; expired items cannot be used
- Toilet paper, toothpaste, shampoo, conditioner, personal hygiene items are welcome
