Know your Ordinances

The wind storm of January raised many questions as to who does the clean up for downed branches, trees, etc.

The Ordinance that addresses non-street closure issues was passed in 1992 and the related section is below;
It is unlawful for any owner, tenant or occupant of any property to permit or maintain thereon the following:

Any accumulation of junk, garbage, refuse, solid waste or other similar material or similar items which are viewable by the public from a public right-of-way.
