IMPORTANT NOTICE

Effective July 31st, 2021 protections for the shut off of utility services for late payments will expire. It is very important to be in touch with the Town Clerk if you need more time to bring your account current. If you are past due <u>because of Covid-19</u> the town does have a payment agreement that can spread out the past due amount over 12 months to avoid shut-off notices. If you are waiting for funds from Community Action please let the clerk know.

As a Reminder the Town Dump is for Natural Vegetation Only. We are still having

people dump garbage and other materials that have to be sorted out and disposed of correctly at the towns expense. If we continue to have issues like this we will start locking the gate due to the misuse of the dump. The town dump takes natural vegetation such as leaves, grass clippings, tree branches (No larger then 2 inch diameter). Thank You.
