

Uniontown Town Council Meeting Minutes

Council Chambers at Town Hall

Called to Order at 6:30 pm by Mayor Shore

Roll Call – All in attendance

Pledge of Allegiance - Hayden

Public Comments – No public comment, but question asked regarding the RV Dump

Consent Calendar – Approved unanimously

Planning and Zoning (Councilmen Davies) – Report given on meeting with PH4H/Maja and corresponding email. Reached out for council advise. Attended on online conference with WADOT regarding potential new regional bus route. Critical Area Ordinance update given.

Public Works (Hayden) – Report given on equipment maintenance, mulch pile, gas leak in Rolling Hills and other town happenings. Winery visit and leak at General Store discussed. Plan devised.

- Councilmen Barry – Inquired about the gas leak in Rolling Hills. Mayor Shore assured him it has been resolved
- Mayor Shore – spoke on the water leak at the General Store and gave direction on how the play should play out

Town Hall (Kim) - Spoke briefly on the new business items. Report given on dog issues in town and presented final bill received from Springbrook and CIAW. Also gave a heads up on incoming interlocal agreement with Whitman County Humane Society.

- Councilmen Davis – How soon will the Interlocal Agreement with Whitman County Humane Society be available. Projected to have ready for review come Jan 2026 meeting

Ordinance Officer (Wesley) – Discussed current conversations with Adam. Update given on whack-a-mole RV.

- Councilmen Warner – Advised we add a mileage notation to the camping ordinance

UCDA (Ashley & Karen) – Thanked the town for helping with the Tree Lighting Event. Update given on barn and Dahmen Barn leases. 2026 plan document created by NormaJean Eagan presented to council.

UCB (Chris & Lori) – Treasurer Report given. Rental prices and potential long term renter update. Report given on duct work issue and resolved gas leak in building. Lori plans to present a new contract at the next Town Council meeting – January 14 2026

New Business

Community Building (Sarah Davis) – Presentation given on her thoughts on youth rental rates for sports and extra-curricular activities.

- Cece – Stated this would be good for the Senior Lunches
- Mayor Shore - Agrees with Sarah but believes that expectations need to be set. Loves to see life in the building, despite the cost.

- Chris and Lori – Both spoke on the breakdown of where the Community Building funds come from
- Councilmen Warner – Requested they provide a proposal
- Wesley – Town spent 28k toward the community building
- Sarah – Wanted to clarify that this was not meant to be personal or knocking the board
- Councilmen Davis – Suggested we look into taxing zip codes and model Rosalia in this practice
